UMCOR CLEANING KITS

UMCOR is depleted of home cleaning kits due to Helene and Milton's direct impacts in the southeast region. We are collecting supplies this week to build as many kits as we can. Please review the shopping list on our website and drop off supplies in the Epworth Youth Center this week. There will be tables set up and labeled for specific items, that way each bucket can be built out through an assembly line. We would love for you to stay after church today and help build the kits and load them to the trailer for delivery!

DAY TRIPS TO AUGUSTA AREA

Sign up to join the relief effort team for work days in the Augusta area - now until the tasks are done. The amount of debris and downed trees in this area is taking a toll on residents. There are people without insurance, or money to pay for a company to remove limbs or whole trees off their homes in order to receive power.
