At Madison FUMC, we are proud to have ministries that offer Christian Growth to young adults and adults with special needs, while at the same time offering support to their families who care for them. Our programs for the intellectually challenged offers two areas of ministry, a Sunday Morning Ministry (SonShiners) and a Community-based Fellowship Group (Jesus Helpers).







Sonshiners

Sonshiners is the name of the Sunday Morning Ministry. Each week, during the 9am service, you will find the back tables in the Wesley Worship Center filled with



friends who meet to worship together. Many are dropped off by family members who may not attend Madison FUMC regularly. Following the worship service, the Sonshiners Group heads to their Sunday School Class, located in the Epworth Youth Center, for Bible lessons, crafts, snacks and fellowship. On the 4th Sunday of each month, the Sonshiners Group continues after the 10am Sunday School Class for a meal and outing together.

Jesus Helpers

Jesus Helpers ("JH Ministries" for short), is a community-based group of young adults and adults with intellectual challenges that meets monthly for fellowship. The group goes on many different types of outings including fishing, pool parties, movies, and

special attractions. In addition, JH Ministries participates in Rec Department ball throughout the year, Summer Camp, Vacation Bible School and takes an annual week-long trip. Trips have included beach destinations, a Disney Cruise, a Mountain Adventure and more.
